

# SKY RANCH BROOM PULL

The weather is cool and the ground is soft. 'Tis the season for pulling broom from our newest open space acquisition, Sky Ranch. Located on the borders of San Anselmo and Fairfax on the shoulder of Bald Hill, Sky Ranch is now part of the Bald Hill Open Space Preserve. This new addition to the preserve offers outstanding views and hiking opportunities. Work is proceeding to restore the landscape to its natural state. Now it is time to remove the invasive, non-native, toxic, and highly-flammable broom that infests the preserve, before it goes to seed.

The San Anselmo and Fairfax Open Space Committees and Marin County Parks are jointly sponsoring a work party to pull broom on Saturday, January 14, 2017, from 9 to 1. Tools and water will be provided. Students can earn community service hours.

After the work party, we will break for lunch of chili and salad. Bring your own drinks of choice and anything you'd like to share.

Meet at Doc Edgar Park on Cascade and Cypress in Fairfax at 9 AM and we will carpool to the preserve. Wear long sleeves and pants, boots, hat, and work gloves. Heavy rain will cancel.
